UL and INDECOPI sign agreement to promote national safety standards and enhance market access for Peru

NORTHBROOK, Ill., January 7, 2009 -- Underwriters Laboratories (UL) and the National Institute for the Defense of Competition and the Protection of Intellectual Property (INDECOPI) announced today an agreement to promote the use of UL Standards for Safety in the ongoing development of national safety standards in Peru via formalized communication and information exchange protocols.
